Students of Textiles and Fashion are trained to become fashion designers, designers or textual designers.

The Gerrit Rietveld Academie, founded in 1967, is an internationally oriented university of applied sciences for fine arts and design with approximately 900 students. It offers a bachelor's degree programme in fine arts and design as well as a number of master's degree programmes. Fashion at the Rietveld is about an open-minded and experimental approach, embracing fashion in its various body-related contexts, testing its boundaries and making it the business to venture beyond. The academy provides an education that enables students to develop into independent designers, tuned into both the contemporary and the visionary.

Amsterdam Fashion Institute was founded in the 1950s by Meester Koetsier and Charles Montaigne. It offers a four-year bachelor's degree programme in Dutch and English. Students choose to specialise in either fashion and design, fashion and management or fashion and branding. The programme provides an excellent basis for a career in the fashion industry. With around 100 lecturers and over 1,100 students, AMFI is currently the largest fashion higher-education institute in the Netherlands and part of the Amsterdam University of Applied Sciences.

Parsons The New School for Design, in New York, is a global leader in design education, with programmes that span the disciplines of design and the fine arts. With the launch of its fashion design programme in 1906, Parsons is credited with the rise of Seventh Avenue, the epicentre of American fashion. Parsons offers a Bachelor of Fine Arts degree in Fashion Design, associate degrees in Fashion Design and Fashion Marketing, and a Master of Fine Arts programme in Fashion Design and Society that was initiated through the support of Parsons alumna Donna Karan. Parsons has educated generations of leading American fashion designers.



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FASHION INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY NY

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The School of Art and Design was established in 1944. It nowadays offers 17 majors to more than 3,800 students pursuing careers in fashion, art and a wide range of design fields. In courses taught by a faculty of working industry professionals who bring industry experience into the classroom, students refine their artistic ability and design sense while acquiring the skills necessary to succeed in today's high-tech marketplace.
